Pacer Plus Consultations in the Pa Enua

What is Pacer Plus? It is a trade and development agreement between members of the Pacific Islands Forum. It stands for Pacific Agreement on Closer Economic Relations (PACER Plus). It's a trade agreement, covering goods, services, investment (this is where BTIB gets involved), labour, sanitary, aid and other areas. It brings to a close of nearly 10 years of negotiations between Australia, NZ and 8 of the Pacific Island Countries.

From the 17 to 20 November, BTIB participated along with Ministry of Agriculture, Customs Department, Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Ministry of Immigration in the Pacer Plus consultations to Mangaia, Mauke, Atiu and Aitutaki. This awareness and consultation program is an outcome of the Cook Islands becoming a signatory to the Pacer Plus trade agreement and the impending date of it coming into effect, which is the 14th of December 2020. The discussions held were vibrant, informative and is fair to say, the islands received the presentations with appreciation, and gained a general understanding of the purpose and benefits of the trade agreement. This agreement has been in the

making for a decade and it is Governments desire to realize that hard work into obvious economic gains.

Those gains - via liberalized trading borders, a predictive investment environment, simplified and transparent processes - would be the ripple effects of economic growth, increased job opportunities, and increased Government revenue; that is improved livelihoods and resilient communities over the long term.

Pacer plus is but one of the vehicles towards growing and diversifying the economy. We look forward to updating everyone on how PACER Plus is progressing at the end of December.

Filing of Annual Returns - Foreign Investment



This is to advise our Registered Foreign Enterprises that filing of your annual returns were due on the 30th of June 2020. This is a mandatory requirement as per Section 34 of the Development Act 1995 – 96 and Section 8 of the Development Investment Regulations 1996. Meitaki maata for those companies who have already filed their annual returns. A friendly reminder to all those companies who have not yet filed their annual returns to submit these as soon as possible. Failure to comply may result in your foreign enterprise registration being revoked or you may face prosecution.
